Notes

When finding interactive activities for maths

1. Just visit <http://my.cjfallon.ie>, click 'Student Resources'
2. You will be brought to a dashboard and will see many links for various books. Select 'primary' up in the top left hand corner.
3. Then beside that, you will see 'level'. Select 2nd class as the level.
4. Click Busy at Maths
5. Click interactive lesson
6. Scroll down for interactive lesson for the page indicated - 104/105/107/108(this week's ones are on page 6 so scroll down to the end and press next).
7. Click on the eye symbol on the right. Each page of the Busy at Maths has its own interactive activity and sometimes a tutorial

When finding Master your Maths 2- mental maths follow steps 1-4 (above)

8. Click Master your Maths 2 and then the eye symbol on the right.
9. You have to fill in your details each time and the book will appear.
10. Type in the page required
11. You can write the answers in your own copy

When finding Feena's Facts

Follow the steps above but click on English. You have to scroll down to the bottom to find Feena's facts and click the eye symbol on the right.

Monday's Maths - Kg Hunt. We use Kg (kilogrammes) to measure weight. If you look carefully at food packages you can see the weight. Kg (kilogrammes) for heavier items and g (grams) for lighter objects.

In your Kitchen find things that weigh 1kg. Lift it and feel how heavy it is. (Hint- sugar and flour is always a good bet!) Did you notice that Kilogrammes can come in different sizes? Look at 1kg of sugar and 1kg of flour. I wonder why they are different???

-Look at different objects in your home. Can you tell- Are they lighter than 1 Kg? Are they heavier? Do they weigh about the same – you could make your own maths table to show your findings.

Seek out objects that weigh $\frac{1}{2}$ kg or 500g and objects that weight $\frac{1}{4}$ kg or 250g

– With permission weigh out 500g of flour/sugar and put in a bag. Now you know what ½ kg feels like to hold. Can you find other objects or packages that weigh ½ kg (extension- do the same with ¼ kg or 250g)
